SOYBEAN CULTIVATION IN UKRAINE

Agriculture plays an important role in Ukraine's economy and has a significant role in socioeconomic development, ensures the country's food security and makes up about 18% of the gross domestic product. Ukraine is a major player in the global food security system; it is the number 1 soya producer in Europe and the sixth top soya exporter in the world.

ADDRESSING THE CHALLENGES

Donau Soja is developing a set of documents, visual materials, and approaches to address the challenges of soya cultivation in Ukraine, including:

- Training on sustainable non-GM soya cultivation practices and techniques;
- Training related to farming with limited resource availability (seeds, fertilisers, fuel etc.);
- Personal on-farm technology consultations;
- Development of knowledge exchange materials;

CHALLENGES FOR THE SOYA SECTOR

Challenges caused by the war in Ukraine. Ukraine is self-sufficient regarding its own soya demand, producing 4–5 times more soybeans than are consumed domestically, making the Ukrainian soya industry export-oriented. The war in Ukraine has affected all areas of life and business including agriculture. Ukraine as one of the major agricultural exporters, is struggling with deliveries via ports due to the Russian occupation of the southern regions and the threat to cargo ships in the Black Sea. Nearly 4.5 million tonnes of crops (including soya) were exported from Ukraine via ports each month. In response to seaports being blocked by the Russian army, Ukrainian companies are investigating and developing alternative export routes to the Western EU, including trucks, railway and the Danube river.

Challenges of sustainable cultivation:

- illegal use of GM soybean varieties;
- widespread use of hazardous pesticides;
- climate change.


Chart. Soya production in Ukraine 2006–2023



CARBON BENEFITS OF DONAU SOJA FROM UKRAINE


BRANDED CARBON FOOTPRINT DATA OF DONAU SOJA CERTIFIED SOYBEANS:

Cultivation of Donau Soja and Europe Soya generates 90% less carbon emissions compared to the average non-certified Brazilian soy.




CARBON FOOTPRINT DATA OF ADAMPOLSOYA CERTIFIED SOYMEAL:
